

Next steps

- We now hope to submit the Section 36 planning application for **Tom na Clach Wind Farm Extension** to the Scottish Government by the Spring of this 2021.
- An Environmental Impact Assessment Report ('EIA Report') including all the results from the surveys will be submitted
 with the planning application. All documents will be uploaded to our website www.tomnaclachwindfarm.co.uk under
 'Downloads'.

 of the Non-Technical Summary (NTS, a condensed version of the EIA Report), please request this in the 'Voice your
